dedicate much of our day through natural environment teaching, and implementing age appropriate Rhode Island Early Learning Development Standards (RIELDS). Your child will be observed by daily interactions, taking anecdotal notes and for milestone progression, every 3 months until they transition into our Toddler Room(s). You can expect to receive daily photos and updates on your infant / yearling, through Pro-Care. We also have a classroom

DOJO that the staff will invite you to for day to day happenings

### Extra Clothing

- Please make sure to replenish these each week...

### What baby will need

- Labeled Diapers in bulk...
- Labeled Wipes in Bulk...
- Labeled PRE MADE bottle
- Soft Sippy cup for water.
- Breast milk baggies can be frozen and we can thaw them and pour...
- If your child eats baby food, please pack a small lunch box daily with their bottles and food they may eat...
- Infants and Yearlings will also require snacks brought in bulk for intermittent snacking...

- A "lovey" from home.
- Soft Sippy Cups when in yearlings...
- Family Pictures to hang on our family Tree
